I. Don't be someone who financially takes on unstable risk.

Take _____ for yourself. (6:1-5)

Becoming "surety" = taking on future debts, co-signing on a loan, becoming "*collateral*", underwriting someone else's risk, etc...

II. Don't be someone who is lazy or sluggish.

_____ yourself. (6:6-11)

The Sluggard= 'sluggish and slow', indecisive, inactive, hesitant, no urgency, always the easy route, the loss of opportunity, shallow, procrastination, unrealistic, disinclined to finish tasks, not useful, lack of desire, no initiative, etc...

III. Don't be someone who sows disruption & discord within the community. Strive for _____ between yourself & others. (6:12-19)
